Welcome to our 2013 price-list, covering this year's range of bulbs for autumn planting.

We wondered what effect the disappointing weather would have on this spring's flowering. We have nonetheless been most reassured by the phone calls from customers telling us what a good show they have had. This will be partly because we always specify the larger size of bulbs, (our tulips are mostly 11/12 cms in circumference, and our daffodils are 14/16). Bigger bulbs produce better flowers and are more likely to naturalise.

New for 2013 are **Autumn and Christmas flowering** bulbs, an increased range of narcissus and new tulip varieties. We have also reintroduced **Imperial Lilies**, now growers have overcome the lily-beetle problems. Price increases have been minimised, but the weather last summer has led to a small increase in prices on tall daffodils and narcissus, snowdrops and English bluebells.

If you would like to order from us this year, please complete the form and send it back to us, or call us and we can fill it in at our end. (This can be quite a good idea if you are looking for any advice, which we are always very happy to give). Delivery, will be made by carrier or post to the address shown on your order. We do not ask for a signature, so please tell us where you would like your order left.

Caring for your bulbs, please unpack your order and store the bulbs in a well ventilated and frost free environment until planting.

Weights and quantities, we sell some daffodils and narcissus by weight when packed. With moisture loss during storage they lose some weight, so late delivered bulbs may weigh less than indicated. With the larger size bulbs, the approximate quantity in a 25kg sack is 300 for daffodils, 400 for narcissi and 600 for Cheerfulness or Actaea.
